Wendell Moore Park Recreational Trails Project



What: Greenways for Oldham County, the Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department, and our partners in planning and constructing nearly 2.5 miles of multiuse trails within Wendell Moore Park will make safe and scenic trails a reality by Labor Day 2008. Phase two of the project will include the rehabilitation of the Senior Center trail segment the connection of that trail to the rest of the Wendell Moore Park trail system once we secure adequate funding. The Wendell Moore Park Recreational Trails will later connect to the Oldham County Interurban Greenways long envisioned for the county. Why: Greenways for Oldham County funding for this project will provide the basic trail network; however, trail and park amenities (benches, waste receptacles, signage, etc) are needed to ensure a quality parks and trails experience for users. Every sponsored bench directly contributes to Greenways for Oldham County's financial commitment to the Wendell Moore Park Recreational Trails Program.

Benefits: Your donation goes directly into the trails project and is fully tax deductible. Many companies will match this gift. In addition to a plaque placed on your bench, individual purchasers will also be recognized on the Greenways for Oldham County website and at the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony.

Timing: Bench placements will be determined on a first come, first serve basis at the time of purchase. Plaque copy will be finalized within two weeks of bench purchase and will be on the bench within six to eight weeks.

Plaques: Adopted benches will have a dedicated plaque recognizing the contributor. Alternatively, the plaque can be in honor or memory of a love one or in children's names as a special memento or to signify a date/occasion.

ADOPT-A-BENCH STANDARDS FOR REFURBISHMENTS & NEW DONATIONS

Appearance and Aesthetics

The Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. and community have an interest in ensuring the best appearance and aesthetic quality of their public facilities. Park elements should reflect the character of the park or facility. All items in the gift program have been selected in such a way that they will not substantially change the character of a facility or its intended use.

Use and Enjoyment

The Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. and the community have an interest in ensuring that all members of the general public have the ability to enjoy and use the parks. For that reason, donations must not interfere with accessibility or use of the park by any member of the public.

Maintenance & Repair

The Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. and the community have an interest in ensuring that park elements be of high quality related to durability and ease of maintenance. Gift items in the donation program have been selected to ensure repair parts and materials will be readily available. Items were also selected to ensure a long life, be resistant to the elements, wear and tear, and to acts of vandalism.

Plaques

All donated benches can be recognized with a plaque. Donors should indicate on the order form provided the desired inscription. Corporations and organizations can have their logo included on the plaque.

Life Cycle of Donation

The Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. considers it our duty to maintain the donation only for the expected life cycle of the donated item. Because park furnishings only last for a matter of years before requiring complete replacement, donated furnishings may become available for renewal after 10 years, with preference given to the original donor. If current information is on file, the donor will be given the opportunity to take further action at the expiration of the original life cycle. If we are unable to contact you or you choose not to renew, the plaque will be removed and the site will be offered to a new donor.

Maintenance

The long-term care and maintenance of donated park elements is important to both the donor and Parks and Recreation Department. The Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. will determine the level of maintenance required for the donated property based upon available budget funding and the type of care needed to reasonably maintain the donation. At the end of the life-cycle term, the donor may choose to extend the life-cycle term by paying for the current value of a new donation. The Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. reserves the right to seek a new donor for the donation at the end of the established life cycle should the original donor choose not to renew the donation, or if the Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. has not been able to contact the original donor.

Removal and/or Relocation

The Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. reserves the right to remove and/or relocate donated park elements and their associated donation acknowledgement/memorial plaque when they interfere with site safety, maintenance or construction activities. In accordance with the previously stated procedure, the Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. will send a registered letter to each identifiable donor notifying the donor of any action related to the disposition of the donation. In certain situations, such as safety or emergency situations, the notification may be made after the action is taken. In the event a donation must be permanently removed, the Oldham County Parks and Recreation Department / Greenways for Oldham County, Inc. will seek an alternative location. If no such location can be found, the memorial plaque can be placed on a different existing park feature at the donor's request.
